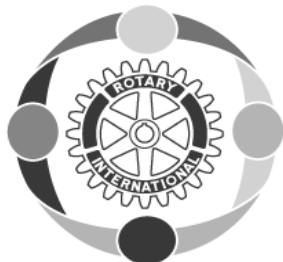

On behalf of Pres Kay, PE Helene called the meeting to order at 12:19 pm and led the Rotary Prayer and followed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

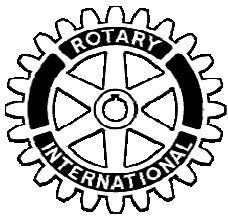
Sgt-at-arms (SAA) Rtn Jim Yeager welcomed all Visiting Rotarian.

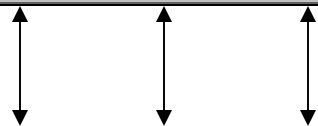

PROGRAM OF THE DAY

Speakers – Mr. Joe Lyszak & Mr. Wilson Forney
Topic – "Community Health Services"

PE Helene invited Rtn Jim Ellis to introduce the guest speakers from Community Health Services (CHS), Mr. Joe Lyszak, Chief Executive Officer and Mr. Wilson Forney, Chief Operating Officer.

Rtn Jim is a current board member of CHS. As a board member, he is aware that many people in the community, particularly those in the business community, lack knowledge on CHS. CHS does wonderful things for our community.

The speakers provided details on the CHC organization and operation:

- ❖ Community Health Centers are local, non-profit, community-owned health care providers serving low income and medically underserved communities.
- ❖ Also known as Federally-Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), they are

located in areas where care is needed but scarce, and to improve access to care for millions of Americans regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay.

- ❖ CHS has a budget of \$5 million, 6 sites, 12 physicians on staff, 4 dentists on staff, and about 70 addition employees.
- ❖ CHS has federal (FTCA) malpractice insurance for all Providers.
- ❖ Main challenges are physician & dentist recruitment, cost of health care technology upgrades, and continued growth & space.
- ❖ Future Plans include developing a House Calls Program, greater reach into the rural areas, working to eliminate health disparities in racial and ethnic groups, and reviewing the possibility of a new main office.

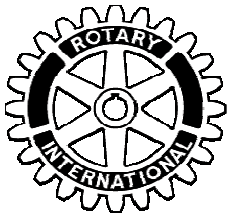

Rtn Dave Fahrbach was the CHOSEN ONE to get \$2.



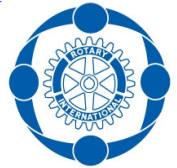
