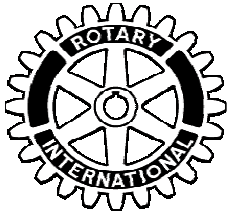

"Joe," he asked, "which company has the slogan, 'Come fly the friendly skies'?"

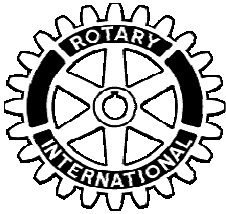
"United." Joe answered.
