SAA Rtn Jim collected money from the following members:

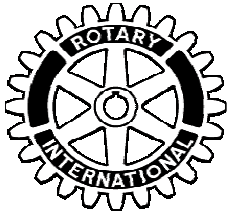
Rtn Angelica Reinhart for being gone next week.

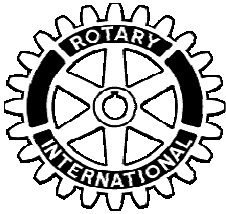

## **PROGRAM OF THE DAY**

Speakers – PDG Jim Shrader & MESA  
Bike Tour Hosting Organizing  
Committee  
Topic – “MESA & MESA Bike Tour 2008  
Hosting by Fremont Rotary Club”

President Elect Rob Lytle invited PP  
Bill Goad to introduce today's first guest  
speaker, PDG Jim Shrader.

PDG Shrader came to speak to the club  
on the topic of MESA to help kick off  
the upcoming MESA bike tour. PDG  
Jim gave a brief history of MESA  
(Medical Equipment and Supplies  
Abroad), which is a Rotary project that  
is unique to our district and stands to  
serve poorer countries, with a focus on  
Central America. Since 2002, roughly  
20 containers of medical equipment and  
school supplies are shipped every year,  
and roughly 20 emergency vehicles have  
been shipped to other countries for their  
use. Not only does the program ship  
containers of supplies that we would  
consider to be out of date emergency  
vehicles but it also helps to set up clean  
water systems to help promote fewer  
diseases caused by dirty water. Because  
of the deficits incurred through the  
program, a bicycle tour was started up to  
help raise money to offset costs of  
running the program.

After his brief history of MESA, Rtn  
Angelica Rinehart stepped in to give a  
brief overview of the festivities of the  
upcoming bike tour, being hosted by the  
Fremont Rotary club. The Pre-tour  
party, which will be free to Fremont  
Rotarians and significant others, will be  
held at Eagle Isle Saturday July 12 from  
6-8pm. If anyone is interested in  
helping with the pre-tour party, contact

PP Tom Hoffman. Out of town riders  
will spend the night at Eagle Isle.  
Sunday July 13, breakfast will be held  
at 7am followed by a 30-minute  
formal program, group picture, and  
flag off no later than 9am. Closing  
ceremonies will be held the following  
week at the barn at Memorial Hospital,  
at approximately 4pm. So far the tour  
has four major sponsors, M.J and Scott  
Michaels, owners of Eagle Isle, Old  
Fort Bank, Memorial Hospital, and  
WAMH Design. Fifty-two club  
members also donated \$10 to offset  
the hosting costs of the event. The  
District has offered to help offset costs  
by printing and selling MESA bike  
tour t-shirts, of which all profit will go  
to offset the hosting costs. A MESA  
website has been set up with all of the  
pertinent information as well as a way  
to RSVP for the pre-tour dinner.  
Pamphlets with the bike tour event  
schedule were passed out. Rotary  
members are still encouraged to ride in  
the tour, even if just for one leg of the  
tour. Radio stations and news media  
have so far been contacted for  
additional coverage and support of the  
bike tour. Finally a gift bag is being  
put together to present to riders. If  
club members are able to provide  
items or support to the gift bag, it  
would be greatly appreciated.

President Elect Rob thanked PDG  
Jim Shrader and Rtn Angelica  
Rinehart with a gift as a token of  
appreciation.
