Rtn Julie Kreilick for that STRIVE program is done for the year and it was a successful one; also for Olivia Beck shadowing her.

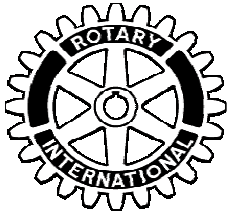

Visiting Rtn Elaine Blackmore for Firelands having 2008 Awards Breakfast on this Wed (May 12) at the Nia Center Kalahari.

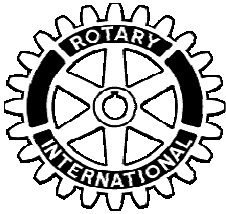

## PROGRAM OF THE DAY

Speaker – Jim Heinrich, District Governor Nominee RY 2009-10  
Topic – “The Ins and Outs of The Rotary Foundation”

President Helene introduced today's guest speaker, Jim Heinrich, District Governor Nominee (DGN) RY 2009-10.

DGN Jim is a graduate of Wapakoneta Blume High School, Ohio University (B.S. in Mechanical Engineering) and an MBA from O.S.U. DGN Jim has been a Professional Engineer in the State of Ohio since 1967. He recently retired from St. Marys Hardware, where he served twenty years as President and CEO.

An active St. Marys Rotarian since 1968, DGN Jim has served two terms on the Board of Directors and was Club President in 1986-1987. At the district level, DGN Jim has served as Assistant Governor, District Chairman of Community Service, District Grant Subcommittee Chairman and as MESA Treasurer.

Rotary Foundation's mission is achievement of world understanding and peace. One of the many notable causes of the foundation is the Polio Plus program which has helped 2 billion children receive vaccinations since 1985. Rotary

Centers for international studies, another program of the foundation, has partnered with seven leading universities world wide, as well as Group Study Exchange which gives travel grants for teams to exchange between countries.

Rotary Foundation also provides ambassadorial scholarships, district simplified grants to help with local short term humanitarian initiatives, volunteer service grants, grants for University teachers, matching grants between countries, and 3H grants for long term grassroots development projects.

President Helene thanked DGN Jim Heinrich with a gift as a token of appreciation.

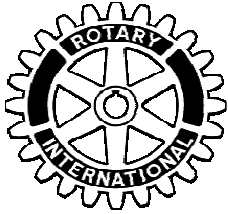

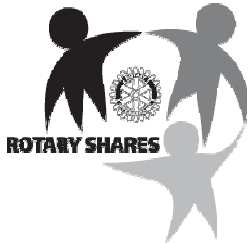
